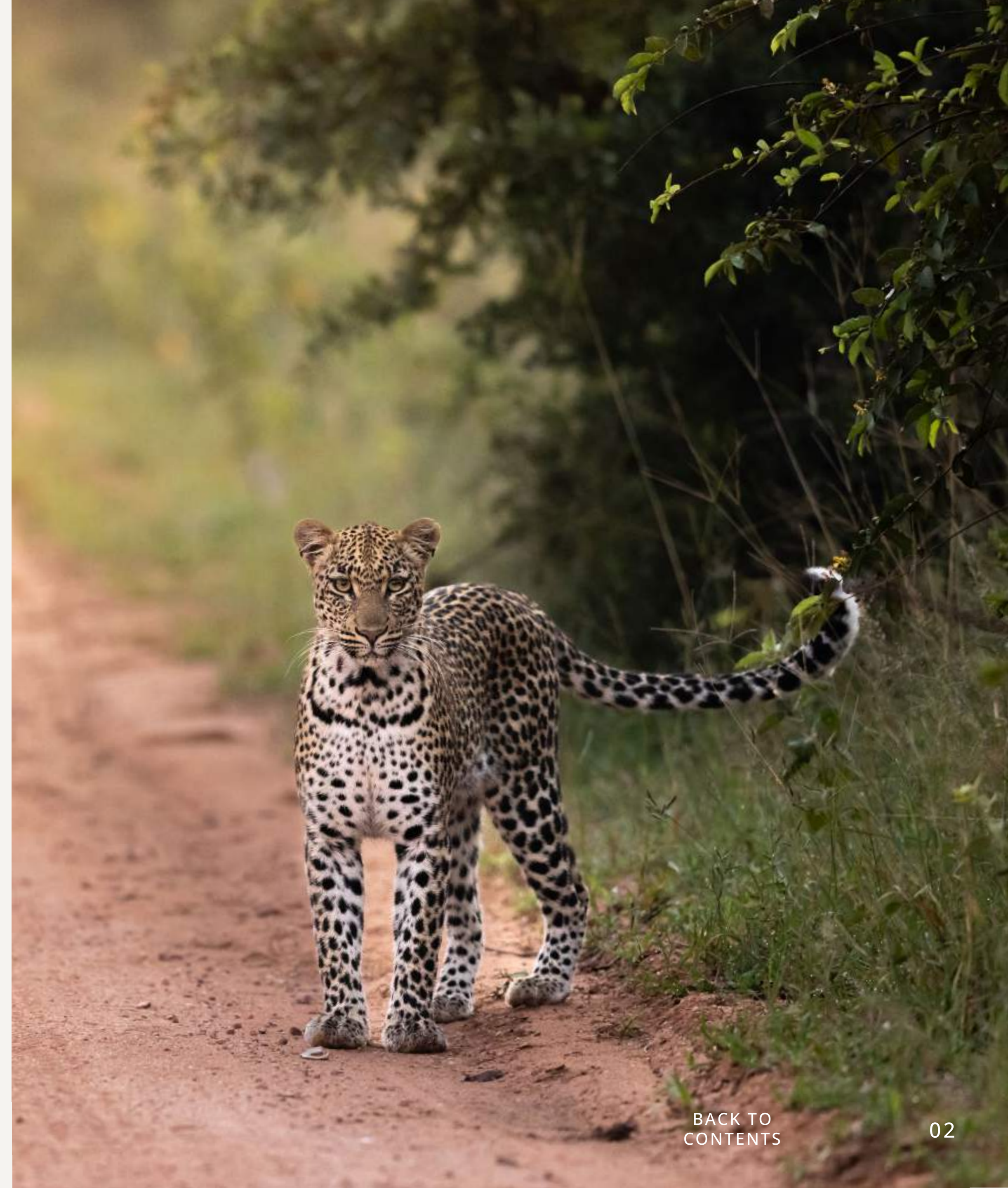

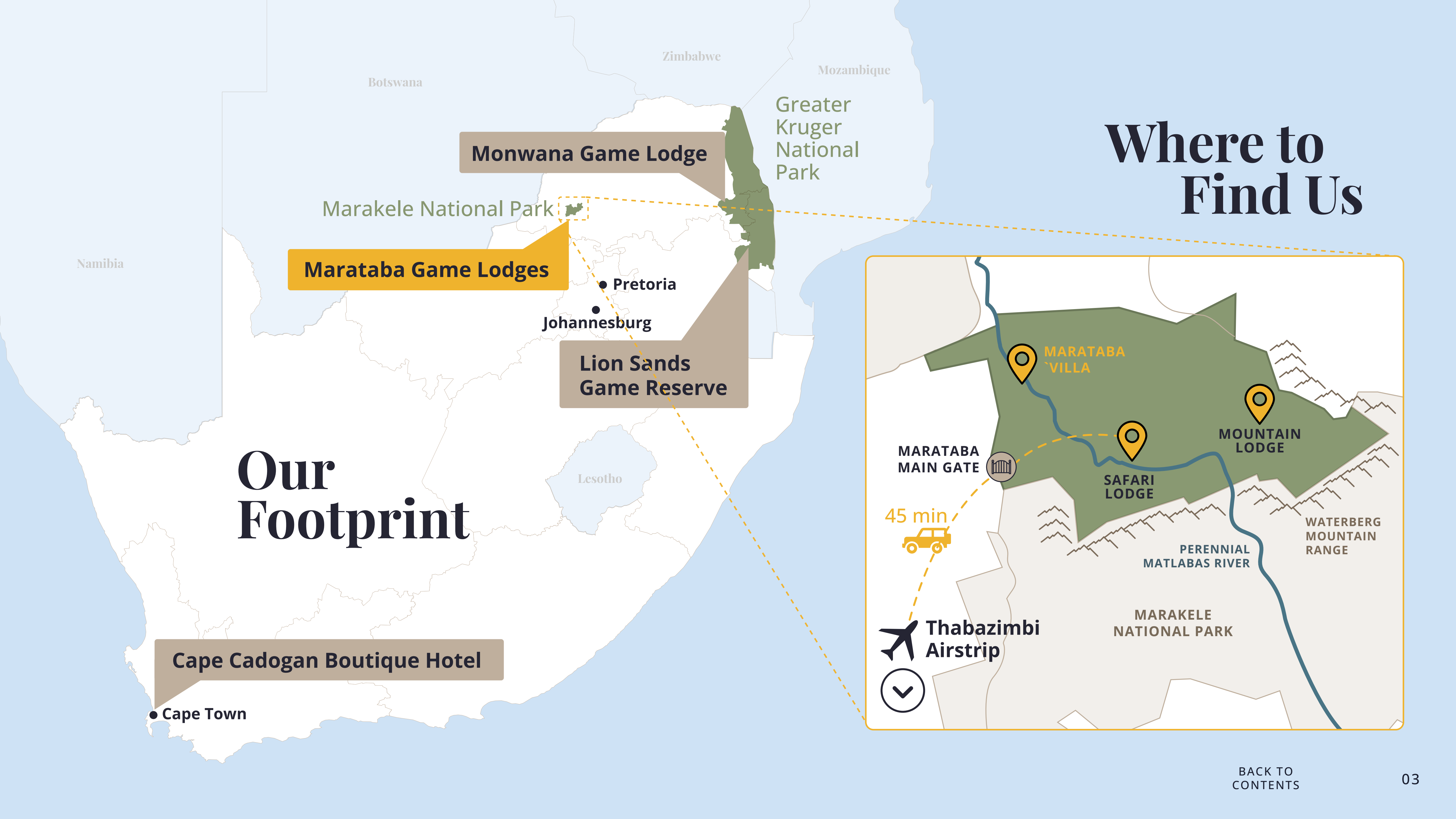

Tucked beside the slow-moving Matlabas River, Marataba Villa is a place to trade rush for river time and reconnect with the people you've come away with. Reserved exclusively for your group, it's the effortless safari base for families and friends – private, spacious, and set quietly within the Waterberg wilderness.

Marataba lies within the malaria-free Marakele National Park, a “place of sanctuary” in Setswana, where nearly 165 560 acres (67 000 hectares) of protected wilderness unfolds across overlapping savannah and mountain landscapes, with the Matlabas River playing a key role in supporting a rich diversity of wildlife.

The Marataba Villa is an exclusive-use retreat set alongside the slow-moving Matlabas River, where wildlife ambles by. Four luxury tents offer space and privacy for everyone, while a central living area draws your group together for leisurely meals, storytelling on the fire deck, and afternoons spent at the pool with wide river views.

Here, everything is shaped around you. A dedicated team (chef, concierge, field guide) takes care of every detail, from coffee at first light to dinner under the stars. With your own safari vehicle and no set schedule, the days move at your pace:

*linger a little longer, head out
when the moment feels right,
and return to a place that feels
entirely your own.*





Our Environmental Commitment

TREADING LIGHTLY, LIVING FULLY

Marataba Villa is designed to exist in quiet conversation with the surrounding landscape, offering an exclusive-use safari experience shaped by space, privacy and a strong connection to nature.

From solar energy and water-wise systems to considered sourcing and low-impact design, daily operations are shaped by the environment in which the villa operates.

This long-term approach to conservation and responsible tourism forms part of a broader commitment across MORE Collection to protect the landscapes, people, and communities connected to our properties.



Remarkable wildlife

Marataba is a privately managed section of 56 834 acres (23 000 hectares) within the malaria-free Marakele National Park conserving 165 560 acres (67 000 hectares) of the Limpopo Waterberg's biodiversity, as well as Iron Age sites of great historical significance. The park falls within the UNESCO-recognised Waterberg Biosphere.

The game here is impressive in number and diversity due to Marataba's location in a transition zone between the dry western and the wetter eastern regions of South Africa. Rare plant species of yellowwood and cedar trees, ancient cycads, and fern trees flourish here.

Experiences and Adventures

BUSH WALKS

Set out on guided bush walks tailored to your passions, from birds and botany to tracking, geology, and the smaller details often missed from a vehicle. Slow the pace and engage all the senses on this immersive experience. (For adults and teenagers aged 16+.)



GAME DRIVES

With your own private safari vehicle and dedicated field guide, every game drive at Marataba Villa is shaped around your group, your interests, your pace, and your wish list. The most rewarding wildlife viewing is typically early morning and late afternoon, when temperatures cool and animals are most active, but there’s no fixed timetable here. If you feel like heading out earlier, staying out longer, or adding an extra adventure, your team is ready when you are. Enjoy unhurried coffee stops and sundowner sessions in the bush.

WATER SAFARI

Drift along the Matlabas on a morning or sunset water safari. Moving quietly along, you’ll look out for hippo, abundant birdlife, and elephant drinking and foraging along the banks. Snacks and beverages are served en-route, turning the slow flow of the river into one of the most peaceful ways to experience the reserve.

WILDLIFE LECTURES

When the weather calls for a quieter moment indoors, our field guides host relaxed, informal wildlife chats. Inspired by your curiosity, topics can range from elephant behaviour and predator dynamics to tracks, birdlife, and the reserve’s broader ecology.

MACK AND MADI KIDS’ ADVENTURE SAFARI CLUB

Designed for young explorers, the Mack and Madi Club is a world of discovery and creativity: eco-garden play, spoor ID, cooking, pool games, kids’ picnics, movie nights, stargazing – all led by a dedicated team.



A NIGHT IN A TREEHOUSE

Spend a night in Thabametsi Treehouse, a solar-powered, two-level hideout. Arrive at sunset for a picnic dinner and Waterberg views, then fall asleep safely under the open sky, with radio contact to a field guide always available. (Must be booked at additional cost in conjunction with villa accommodation.)

SPA AND WELLNESS

Wind down with a spa treatment in your room or on your private deck during the quiet between safaris. Choose from massages, facials, and more, using herbal-infused, ethically sourced products from TheraNaka™. Yoga mats are available for slow, grounding stretches and simple breathwork – an easy way to reset and begin or end the day in tune with the river’s calm.

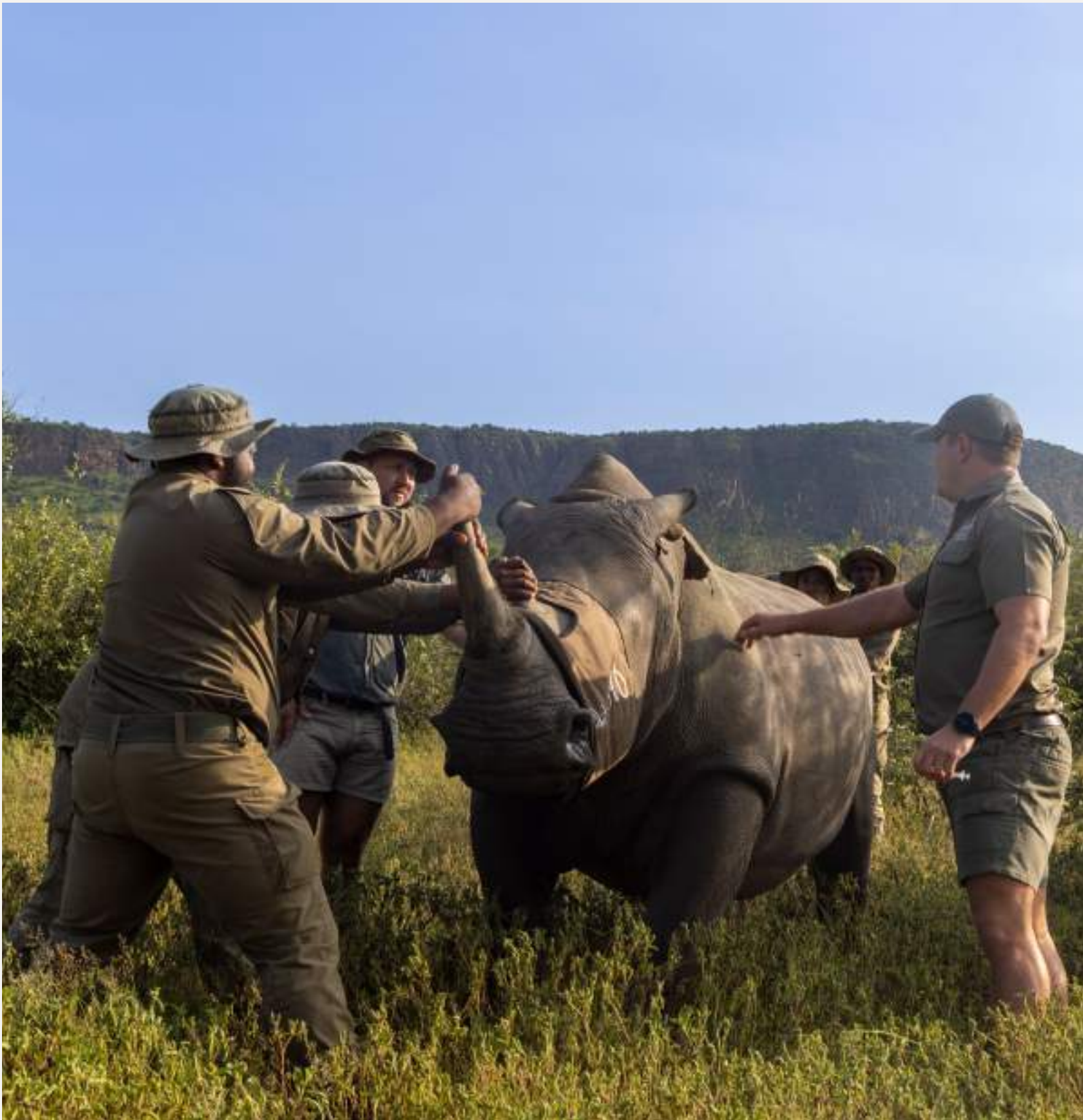


LOCAL COMMUNITY EXPERIENCES

Visit Heuningvei Primary School and the Itsoseng Daycare Centre in the Sentrum Community. This guided experience offers a meaningful connection with the people shaping young lives and directly supports the communities you visit - turning your stay into lasting impact.

RHINO CONSERVATION SAFARI

Gain insight into the ongoing conservation work supporting critically endangered black rhinos and near-threatened white rhino populations alongside specialist veterinary teams during key wildlife interventions. (Additional costs apply.)

Practical information

GETTING HERE



BY AIR

- Scheduled flights or private charters to Thabazimbi Airstrip
- Helicopter arrivals to Marataba Safari Lodge by arrangement with a transfer to the villa



TRANSFERS

- Approximately 40 minutes by road from Thabazimbi Airstrip



BY ROAD

- Approximately 4 hours (200 miles | 320km) from Johannesburg via well-maintained roads



WHAT TO PACK

- Neutral clothing for game drives and bush walks
- Warm layers for mornings and evenings, even in summer
- Comfortable hiking boots/shoes
- Swimwear
- Sun protection, including a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen
- Camera/binoculars
- Yoga mats provided upon request

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Marakele National Park is malaria-free – no anti-malarial medication required
- Closest hospital: Mediclinic Thabazimbi Hospital (1 hour)

CONNECTIVITY

- Wi-Fi throughout the villa
- Mobile coverage keeps you in touch when necessary
- International power outlets and USB charging points

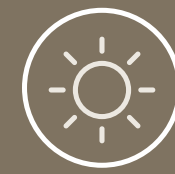
Weather and seasonal highlights

Marakele National Park is a year-round destination, with temperatures ranging from 70°F (21°C, winter min: 38°F/ 3°C) to 95°F (35°C, summer); rainfall peaks from December to February. Each season brings its own character and wildlife moments to Marataba.



SPRING (September – November)

- **Temperature:** 52–72 fahrenheit | 11–22 celsius
- **Rainfall:** 5.9 inches | 150 millimeters
- **Wildlife highlights:** Newborn wildlife begin to appear, early migrants join residents
- **Landscape:** First rains spark wildflowers and lush green landscape
- **Seasonal appeal:** Flowering plants, bird activity at its brightest



SUMMER (December – February)

- **Temperature:** 70–95 fahrenheit | 21–35 celsius
- **Rainfall:** 13.7 inches | 350 millimeters
- **Wildlife highlights:** Excellent birdwatching; young Big Five members appear frequently
- **Landscape:** Warm, dramatic thunderstorms; vibrant landscape and vivid sunsets
- **Seasonal appeal:** Lush, landscapes and abundant birdlife



AUTUMN (March – May)

- **Temperature:** 59–77 °F | 15–25 °C
- **Rainfall:** 6 in | 150 mm
- **Wildlife highlights:** Resident raptors remain active; Big Five easier to spot
- **Landscape:** Calm, golden light; excellent for photography
- **Seasonal appeal:** Clear game viewing as bush recedes; wildlife rallies around water sources



WINTER (June – August)

- **Temperature:** 39–68 °F | 4–20 °C
- **Rainfall:** 0.4 in | 10 mm
- **Wildlife highlights:** Animals concentrate at waterholes, making for easier sightings
- **Landscape:** Sparse bush makes animal sightings exceptional
- **Seasonal appeal:** Clearest skies for evening stargazing; crisp mornings, mild days, cosy fires in the evening

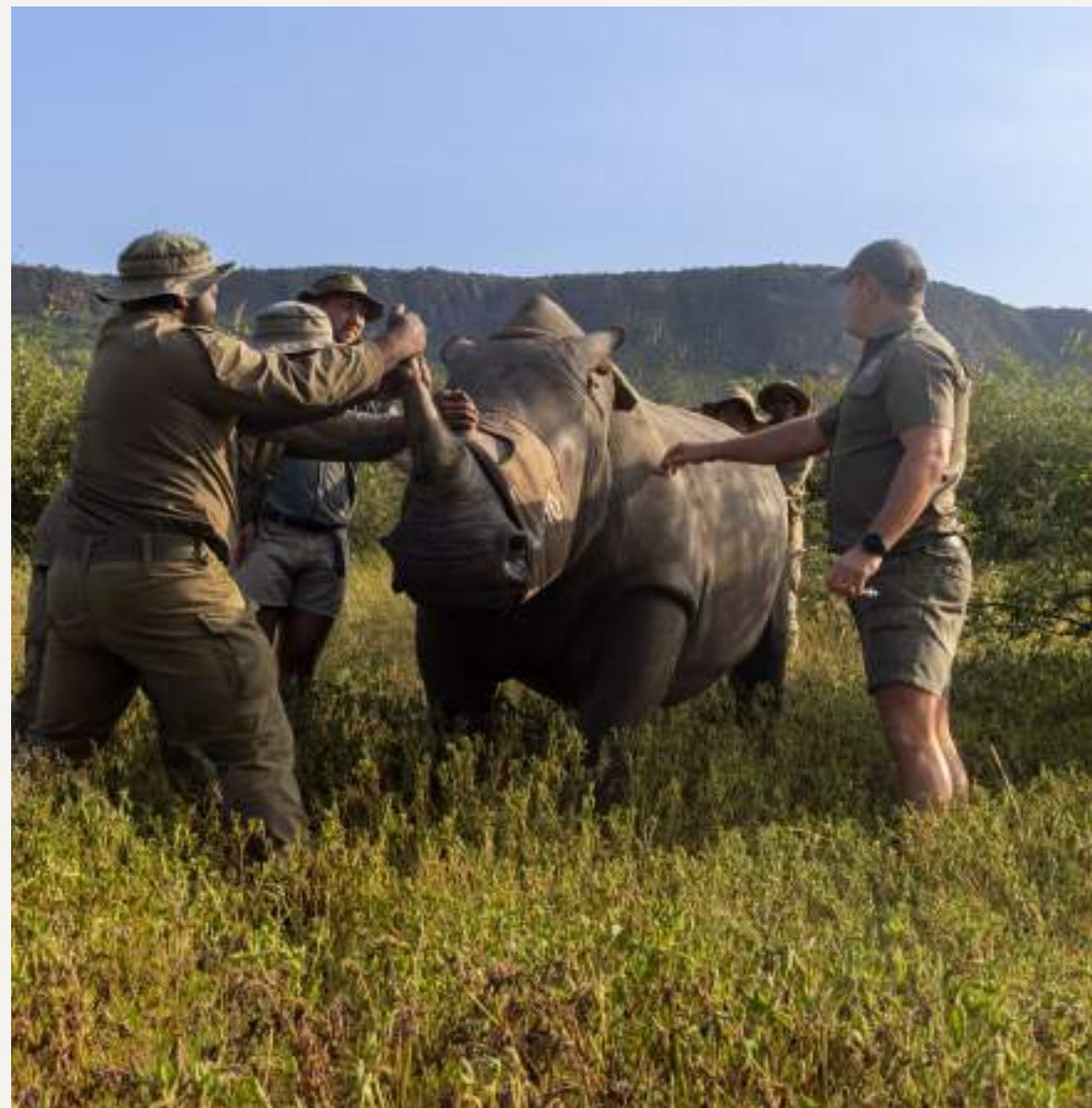
